Your Taxation, Election and Records Committee presents herewith a Resolution amending a previous Resolution designating the precinct boundaries for the 449 voting precincts in Lake County townships. Adjustments to nine precinct boundaries will eliminate unique ballot styles which occur as a result of local units of government annexing new property and/or new voter registrations occurring. The adjustments ensure that voters maintain their right to privacy on how they mark their ballot.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Lake County has 449 voting precincts in 18 townships; and

WHEREAS, two Antioch Township precinct boundaries adjustments for four parcels of land will eliminate two unique ballot styles; and

WHEREAS, one Ela Township precinct boundary adjustment for one parcel of land will eliminate one unique ballot style; and

WHEREAS, two Libertyville Township precinct boundaries adjustments for four parcels of land will eliminate two unique ballot styles; and

WHEREAS, one Warren Township precinct boundary adjustment for two parcels of land will eliminate one unique ballot style; and

WHEREAS, two Wauconda Township precinct boundaries adjustments for three parcels of land will eliminate two unique ballot styles; and

WHEREAS, one West Deerfield Township precinct boundary adjustments for three parcels of land will eliminate one unique ballot style; and

WHEREAS, the precinct adjustments will protect voter privacy and will cause a change of polling place for one or more voters in eleven instances and no change of polling place in six instances.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, the attached Exhibit A sets forth the parcels of land, precinct movement and change in polling places for the 17 parcels of land involved and Exhibit B sets forth copies of the notification sent to each registered voter affected by the precinct movement and each voter shall receive a new Certificate of Registration setting forth the precinct number and polling place location.
