


MADAM CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State's Attorney has received a notice of renewal for the Violent Crime Victims Assistance Program, budgeted at \$24,660, awarded by the Office of the Illinois Attorney General for the time period July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004; and

WHEREAS, \$24,660 was originally appropriated in the FY 2003 budget for this Program to supplement the salary of the full-time Domestic Violence Counselor; and

WHEREAS, it should be noted that it will be necessary for the County to provide additional compensation and benefits valued at approximately \$28,983 without reimbursement from the Office of the Illinois Attorney General for the full-time Domestic Violence Counselor; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County State's Attorney, Law and Judicial Committee and Financial and Administrative Committee recommend the continuation of this Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the Lake County State's Attorney's Violent Crime Victims Assistance Program with the Office of the Illinois Attorney General is hereby authorized; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board, the Lake County State's Attorney, and the Lake County Treasurer are hereby authorized to execute the necessary documentation in order to accept the renewal (program agreement to be attached hereto and hereby made a part of this Resolution); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that offsetting revenue in the amount of \$24,660 from the Office of the Illinois Attorney General will be deposited in the proper revenue account; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State's Attorney shall serve as project director for the program, and accurate records of all necessary grant compliance requirements shall be kept by the State's Attorney Office.
