WHEREAS, the Teamsters Local Union No. 714, Law Enforcement Division has been recognized as the sole and exclusive bargaining agent for certain employees of the Lake County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, a Collective Bargaining Agreement has been negotiated with the Teamsters Local Union No. 714, Law Enforcement Division, as the exclusive representative of the Sergeants of the Lake County Sheriff's Office, consistent with the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act; and

WHEREAS, your Financial and Administrative Committee has reviewed and approved said agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this the County Board of Lake County, that the Chairman of the Board is hereby authorized to sign the Collective Bargaining Agreement attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Agreement shall be effective from December 1, 2003 through November 30, 2007 consistent with the Chapter 5 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, Section 315\21.
