RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 5-102 of the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance, proposals were called for by publication for establishing contracts with qualified providers for psychological services for counseling and professional services for adults and juveniles for the Lake County Psychological Services Division of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit Court commencing on or about July 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to said publication, request for proposals were extended to eighty-eight (88) service providers; and

WHEREAS, a Selection Review Committee will recommend awards be made to multiple service providers offering the most favorable proposals to Lake County to meet the diverse needs of the adult and juvenile populations to be served; and

WHEREAS, the following maximum rates have been established for psychological services; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Central Services is hereby authorized to execute contracts in accordance with the rates established herein and the recommendations of the Lake County Psychological Services Division;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the Director of Central Services is hereby directed to enter into contracts throughout the contract period at the rates established herein with service providers as identified by the Psychological Services Division to provide services necessary to the operations of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit Court for adults and juveniles.
