



WHEREAS, the County of Lake on behalf of the Lake County State's Attorneys Office and the City of Waukegan has applied for an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant that provides grant monies to local governments to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime and to improve the criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County State's Attorneys Office will use this funding to produce materials, procure computer equipment, and to provide education and information to domestic violence victims; and

WHEREAS, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant is in the amount of \$21,529, and it is necessary to appropriate this amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the acceptance and execution of an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant from the United State Department of Justice for the Lake County State's Attorneys Office is hereby authorized; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$21,529 is hereby authorized in:

Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant JAG

- This is an application for grant monies from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistant Grant Program. This funding supports a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime and to improve the criminal justice system.
- Under this program the City of Waukegan and the County of Lake on behalf of the Lake County State's Attorneys Office are eligible for a joint award of \$81,961 in FY2005 grant monies.
- The potential allocation of the eligible funds is \$21,529 to the County of Lake on behalf of the State's Attorneys Office and \$60,432 to the City of Waukegan.
- The State's Attorneys Office will use the \$21,529 to enhance the domestic violence program (see budget proposal and budget narrative). The City of Waukegan will use the \$60,432 to purchase radios and peripherals for the Waukegan Police Department.

Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant

Narrative

The Edward Byrne memorial justice assistance grant program allows local governments to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime.

All of the funds allocated to the Lake County State's Attorneys Office will be used to enhance the domestic violence program. The Lake County State's Attorneys Office prosecutes approximately 300 domestic violence cases a month. These funds will allow us to reach victims of domestic violence by providing education and information. Currently we have a domestic violence safety plan card that provides general domestic violence information. We will be using the funds to produce more of these cards and to also create a new safety plan for children. We will expand on the literature distributed to every domestic violence victim by creating new brochures and safety plans and producing more of our current information.

We will also be purchasing new equipment and software for our domestic violence counselors. The equipment will allow the counselors to train outside agencies on domestic violence, and will allow us to better track our domestic violence cases. By purchasing updated equipment and creating new literature we will be able to reach victims of domestic violence more effectively.
