## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority has provided funding to the Children's Advocacy Center for a Bilingual Victim Advocate since 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority has submitted an amendment to the interagency agreement #205209, extending the grant period by twelve months, to cover the period October 1, 2005 through September 30, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the grant would provide an additional \$35,280 in funding to offset the cost of salary & benefits for the position; and

WHEREAS, the State's Attorneys Office recommends that the County Board authorize the Chairman of the County Board to execute the necessary documents to accept the grant renewal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the Chairman of the Lake County Board is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents for the renewal of an interagency agreement with the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority to provide funding for the Children's Advocacy Center Bilingual Victim Advocate.

**Children's Advocacy Center Services  
Bi-lingual Victim Advocate**

This is an amendment of the Children's Advocacy Center Services interagency agreement #205059 between the State's Attorneys Office Children's Advocacy Center and the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority (ICJIA).

- In 1999 the Children's Advocacy Center implemented this grant for a bilingual victim advocate. The victim advocate provides comprehensive supportive services to child victims and their non-offending family members throughout the court process.
- This grant funds the salary of the victim advocate and a small portion of program expense. The grant does not fund fringe benefit expense.
- From 1999 to 2003 the employee on this grant was a Children's Advocacy Center contractual employee and did not have medical, dental and life insurance, retirement and other benefits.
- In February of 2003 this victim advocate position was added to the State's Attorneys Office position inventory and the employee on this grant received fringe benefits. The Children's Advocacy Center received the ICJIA funding and reimbursed the State's Attorneys Office for the salary and fringe benefit expense.
- Beginning with this grant year (October 2005 through September 2007) the State's Attorneys Office will receive the funding from the ICJIA. The Children's Advocacy Center will fund the match and over-match. The management center for this grant will need to be revised to reflect the increased amounts for revenue and expenses.
