RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority has announced the continuation of a 12 month grant in the amount of \$92,622 for the State's Attorney's Prosecutor-Based Victim Services program to provide advocacy services to victims of violent crimes during the period October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the grant program will fund a portion of salary and benefits for a full-time (job-shared) victim assistance counselor in the Felony Review Division, and a full-time Spanish speaking counselor in the Felony Trial Division; and

WHEREAS, the program budget of \$92,622 was submitted, comprising \$60,569 federal funds, \$7,755 State's Attorney Asset Forfeiture account funds, and \$24,298 from the State's Attorney's budget; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the County provides \$74,600 of the total program budget for salaries, fringe benefits and indirect costs not covered by the grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant must be formally accepted by the County of Lake and an appropriation must be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that Program Agreement #206077 with the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the Lake County State's Attorney's Prosecutor-Based Victim Services program in the amount of \$92,622 for the period October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007, is hereby accepted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board, the Lake County State's Attorney, and the Lake County Treasurer are hereby authorized to execute the necessary documentation in order to accept the grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the transfer of \$7,755 from Fund 760 to Fund 101-3311010-49920 as part of the local match is hereby authorized and that \$60,569 of federal revenue will be deposited in Fund 101-3311010-2399; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State's Attorney shall serve as project director for the program, and accurate records of all necessary grant compliance requirements shall be kept by the State's Attorney Office.
