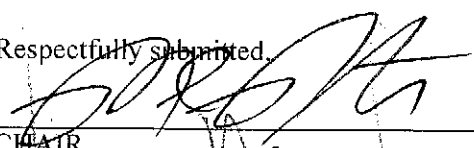

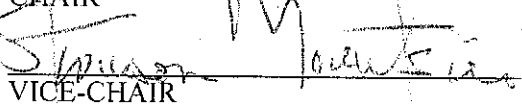
MADAM CHAIR AND MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD:

Your Financial and Administrative Committee presents herewith a resolution expressing official intent regarding certain capital expenditures to be reimbursed from proceeds of an obligation.

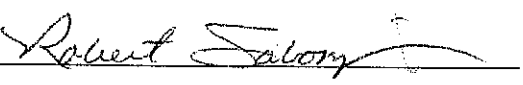

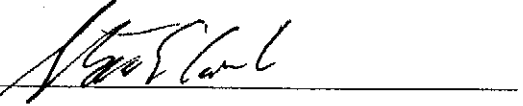

RESOLUTION NUMBER _____

A RESOLUTION of The County of Lake, Illinois, expressing official intent regarding certain capital expenditures to be reimbursed from proceeds of an obligation.

WHEREAS The County of Lake, Illinois (the "*County*"), by its County Board and in accordance with authority pursuant to 5 ILCS 70/5, Omnibus Bond Acts and 30 ILCS 350/15, Local Government Debt Reform Act, has determined it to be necessary or advisable for the public health, safety, welfare, and convenience to undertake the projects or purposes described as follows:

1. New building and equipment to provide heating and cooling to other County owned buildings and generally located on the County's Libertyville campus at the northwest corner of Milwaukee Ave and Winchester Road, Libertyville, Illinois
2. New building and equipment for a new courtroom building generally located at 301 Greenleaf St., Park City, Illinois

(collectively the "*2007 County Improvement Projects*"); and

WHEREAS all or a portion of the expenditures (the "*Expenditures*") relating to the 2007 County Improvement Projects have been paid within the sixty days prior to the passage of this Resolution or will be paid on or after the passage of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS the County reasonably expects to reimburse itself or pay for the Expenditures with the proceeds of an obligation, which the County now intends to be a tax-exempt obligation under Section 103 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended;

WHEREAS such tax-exempt obligation will not be issued until the proceeds of such obligation are needed to reimburse or pay the Expenditures, in order to avoid any unnecessary costs associated with these types of obligations such as incurring possible arbitrage penalties, and to allow the County to maintain level debt service payments by waiting until sufficient current debt is repaid;

NOW THEREFORE Be It and It is Hereby Resolved by the County Board of The County of Lake, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Reimburse. The County reasonably expects to reimburse or pay the Expenditures with proceeds of an obligation.

Section 2. Amount. The maximum principal amount of the obligations expected to be issued for the 2007 County Improvement Projects is \$13,500,000.

Section 3. Further Actions. All actions of the officers, agents, and employees of the County that are in conformity with the purposes and intent of this Resolution, whether taken before or after the adoption hereof, are hereby ratified, confirmed and adopted.

Section 4. Effective Immediately. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
