



## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the Veterans Assistance Commission (VAC) of Lake County has been approved for a one-time donation totaling \$4,500 from the Veteran Service Organizations (VSO) of Lake County to be utilized for the purchase of Virtual Vet software system for assisting the veterans of Lake County; and

**WHEREAS**, the VAC of Lake County currently provides assistance with claims through its budgeted Assistance to Veterans account (73010); and

**WHEREAS**, the Veterans Assistance Commission has coordinated this purchase with the county's Information Technology Department and the new program replaces the current program that 16 years old and provides the security, accessibility, portability and serviceability needed; and

**WHEREAS**, acceptance of VSO's of Lake County donation would allow the VAC to expand it's claim services and the number of veterans able to be served; and

**WHEREAS**, the purchase and donation acceptance is contingent on a fifty percent county match totaling \$4,500 to be provided from the VAC's Assistance to Veterans account #208-3700010-73010; and

**WHEREAS**, the VAC of Lake County requests approval to accept the VSO's of Lake County grant to utilize these funds for the purchase of the Virtual Vet software program to service the veterans of Lake County; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency appropriations are necessary to formally accept this donation for the software purchase and distribute as follows:

Increase Capital budget:	208-3700010-84040	\$9,000

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois that authorization is hereby approved for the Veterans Assistance Commission's acceptance of a one-time \$4,500 donation from the VSO's of Lake County for the purchase of the Virtual Vet software program; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the revenue and expense budgets shall be appropriated as specified above; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Veterans Assistance Commission shall serve as project director and accurate records of all necessary compliance requirements shall be maintained by the Veterans Assistance Commission.
